Main objective:

AdriGov aims to strengthen the institutional cooperation in the Adriatic-Ionian area. The project will define and implement an Adriatic governance operational plan, reinforcing the institutional cooperation and promoting a shared model of governance in the Adriatic and Ionian basin.

Specific objectives:

- Contribute to define the new cross border cooperation in post IPA planning
- Set up a pilot action on multilevel governance
- to improve the local authorities planning capacity, through training courses and experience exchanges in order to acquire specific skills concerning European project cycle management, structural funds management, fund raising and networking activities.
